



Vermont Route 14 Bridge Replacement Project
May 2, 2019

The Vermont Agency of Transportation has resumed work on the Vermont Route 14 Bridge Project in E Montpelier village. Next week (May 6 - May 10) the contractor, CCS Constructors, Inc., will:

- Continue installation of about 100 feet of new curb and new sidewalk from the edge of the bridge extending North along the south side of Route 2 (in the area where the temporary bridge and construction equipment was located). New curb will also be put in on the north side of Route 2 (west bound lane) in front of the traffic signal connecting the curbs that were poured in 2018.
- Install a sand filter on the south side of the bridge to collect and filter run off from Route 14 before discharging water into the Winooski River (if materials are available).

Traffic impacts

When the contractor works on the Route 2 shoulder there will be one-lane travel during non-peak hours, 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Otherwise lane reductions will be intermittent during the rest of the week. **Please exercise caution and observe the 25 mph speed limit** while driving through the work zone.

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
