



Vermont Route 14 Bridge Replacement Project
May 23, 2019

The Vermont Agency of Transportation will continue work on the Vermont Route 14 Bridge Project in E Montpelier village next week (May 28 - May 31). The contractor, CCS Constructors, Inc, will not work on Monday, Memorial Day.

Next week the contractor will:

- Cold plane 25 feet on all three roadway ends of the project and at both ends of the bridge on Tuesday.
- Install the final layer of paving. This work will be done Tuesday (May 28) and Wednesday (May 29) nights.
- Complete installation of a sand filter on the south side of the bridge to collect and filter run off from Route 14 before discharging water into the Winooski River.
- Continue site restoration work by planting grass seed and installing mulch and grubbing (tree roots/stumps). Grubbing materials will be placed along the riverbank to minimize erosion.

Box Culvert Installation

As part of a coordinated project, East Montpelier NH CULV (54), VTrans has contracted with J. Hutchins Inc. to replace a deteriorated box culvert to the east. Next week J. Hutchins will be on-site to install erosion control measures and construct a temporary road widening for anticipation of the box culvert installation the following week. This project is expected to be completed by the end of June.

No roadway restrictions will be in place for the box culvert work and flaggers will be utilized as needed.

Traffic impacts

There will be one-way alternating traffic next week as follows:

- On Tuesday during the day at non-peak hours, 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM.
- On Tuesday and Wednesday evenings, from 7 PM to 6 AM.

Flaggers will assist motorists through the work zone. Otherwise lane reductions will be intermittent during the rest of the week. **Please exercise caution and observe the 25 mph speed limit** while driving through the work zone.

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
